01. Virtual Reality and education

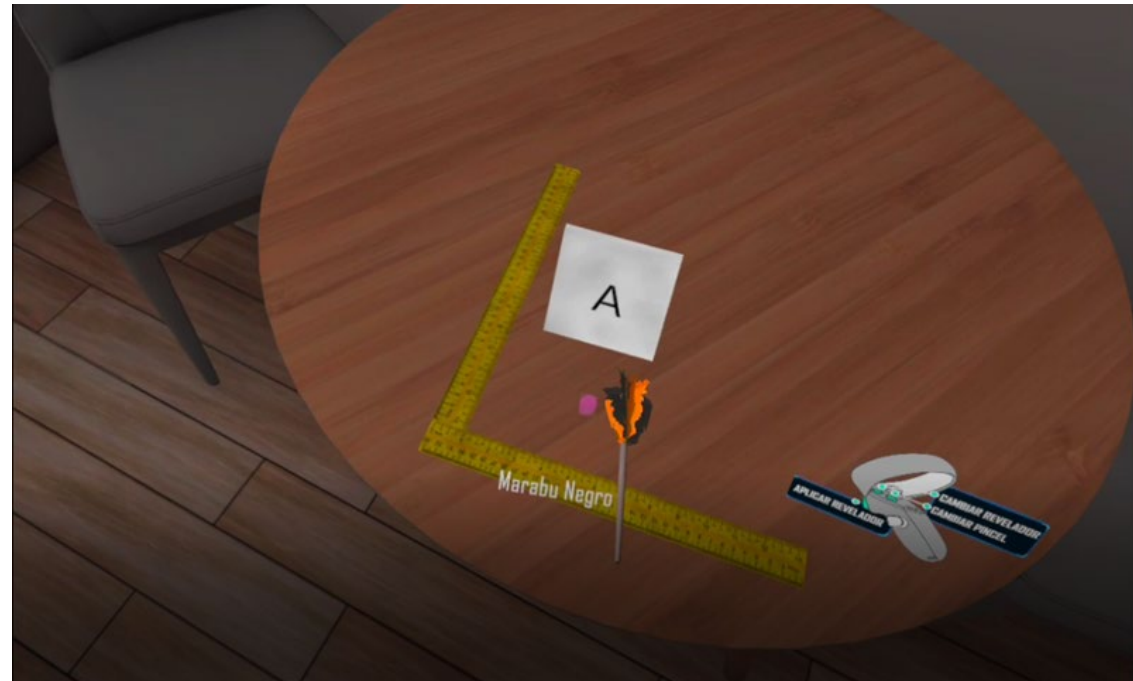
To use Virtual Reality for criminal inspection as it enabled the recreation of a multitude of different scenarios in which to practice the steps to follow in the performance of these inspections.
