

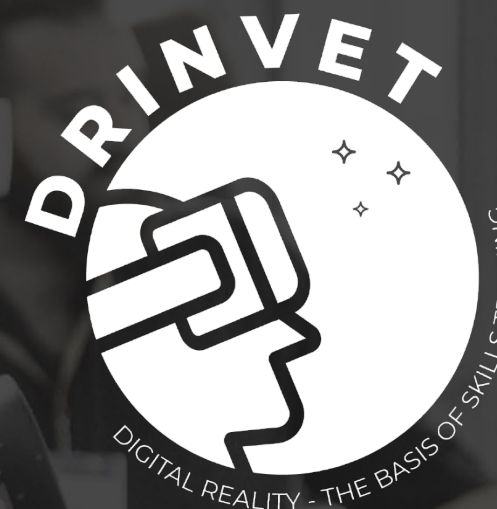

PREWORK

To create a virtual tour, you need to have Adobe Lightroom installed, create an account on kuula.co and download the Theta app on your smartphone





STEPS

1. Mount camera on monopod







STEPS

2. Connect camera and smartphone

Connect to Camera WiFi

1. Disconnect USB cable from camera.
2. Turn on the camera WiFi.
3. Verify camera WiFi is found by your computer. For example:
THETAY12345678.OSC

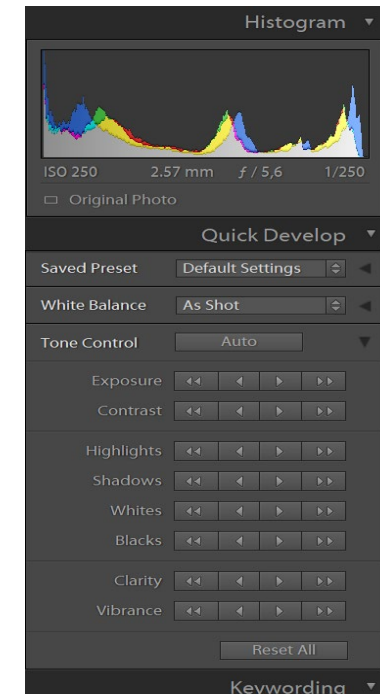
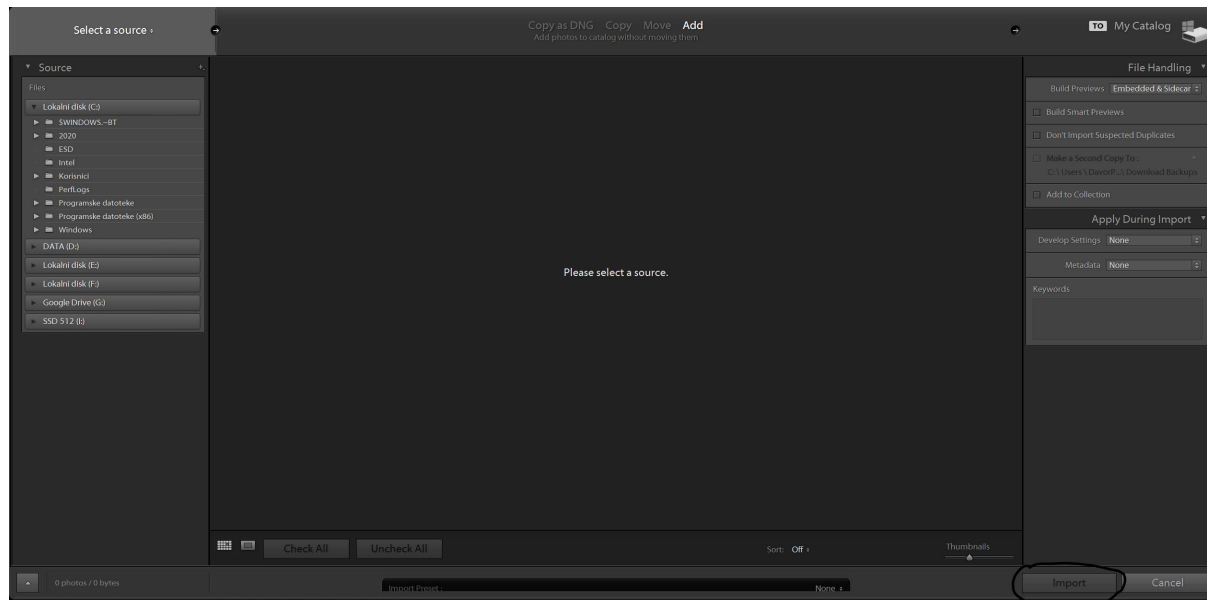
4. Transfer pictures to the PC

Conclusion: No matter how many panoramas we have, the procedure is always the same. Take pictures with a camera, process them in Lightroom, upload them to Kuula, connect them to each other on Kuula.
